Mike Morris seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 voice vote.

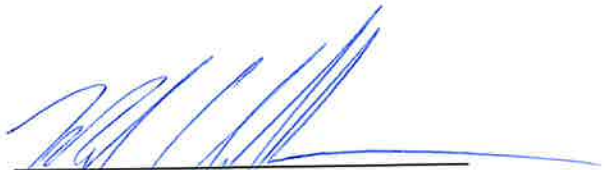
Public Comment

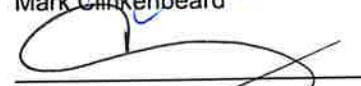

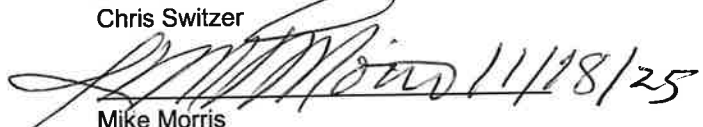
Comments or other business from Commissioners or other Elected Officials.
