Reports from committees

President Thacker gave a brief update on the Baker Tilly study. Communication had been sent out to the Department Heads. Jada Kent of Baker Tilly was present at the meeting and would be meeting with any Department heads who had set up an appointment for the next couple of days. This is to clean up or correct any information given for the study. Jada Kent introduced herself and spoke briefly. Norm Loudermilk asked what the next step would be after meeting with Baker Tilly. President Thacker said that if changes or alterations to the study resulted from the meetings, Ms. Kent would make recommendations to the Council and the Council will make the ultimate decision on what to do with that information. Mr. Loudermilk asked if the department heads would be notified of the results and, if so, by whom. President Thacker said the Council would make the notification. There was a short discussion.

Resolutions and Ordinances other than appropriations.

There were none.

Ordinances relating to appropriations. OLD BUSINESS

i. Additional Appropriation 2023-03B: Clerk – delete part time positions and add full time positions

This additional appropriation is to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-03 which was approved last month.

ii. Additional Appropriation 2023-05B: Juvenile Justice Center – Salary Increases, Stipends & Retention Bonuses

This additional appropriation is to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-05 which was approved last month.

iii. Additional Appropriation 2023-07B: Coroner – Add Chief Deputy Coroner Position

This additional appropriation is to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-07 which was approved last month.

iv. Additional Appropriation 2023-10B: Sheriff – Secretary (moved from Jail budget)

This additional appropriation is to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-10 which was approved last month.

v. Salary Ordinance 2023-20A: Sheriff – Add Corporal Stipend

This was a request from the February Sunshine meeting that was inadvertently omitted from subsequent meetings in February and March. A copy of the page from the initial request was been included in the packet. The amount is small enough that it will not require an additional appropriation but Council will need to decide whether or not to approve the request. Officer Derek Fell said they planned to request during their meeting with Baker Tilly for this to be the same level for this post as their jail officers staff.

vi. Salary Ordinance 2023-11: Prosecutor – Amend Deputy Prosecutor Base Salary

At the request of the Prosecutor's Office, this matter has been tabled until next month after their meeting with Baker Tilly.

vii. Salary Ordinance 2023-12: Prosecutor – Add Deputy Prosecutor Percentage Increase

At the request of the Prosecutor's Office, this matter has been tabled until next month after their meeting with Baker Tilly.

viii. Salary Ordinance 2023-13: Prosecutor – Add Deputy Prosecutor Positions (3)

At the request of the Prosecutor's Office, this matter has been tabled until next month after their meeting with Baker Tilly.

ix. Additional Appropriation 2023-14B: Prosecutor – Add Legal Secretary Position

This additional appropriation is to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-14, as amended, which was approved last month. This position will coordinate and perform record keeping for community service hours.

x. Additional Appropriation Ordinance 2023-25: LIT/Public Safety – Mental Health America

Myra Wilkey said she would like to withdraw the request. The City has provided funds to cover the \$500,000. She may come back at a later time with a request.

NEW BUSINESS

i. Additional Appropriation Ordinance 2023-15B: Vigo County Health Department – Reimburse Recreational Trails

Joni Wise, Administrator of the Vigo County Health Department, said they had received federal reimbursements for Covid-19 vaccine administrative costs. To date, they have used those funds to purchase a car, two trucks, and donated \$300,000 to all the fire districts for the purchase of Lucas 3 Stryker CPR devices for every district. The next reimbursement amount they have coming in, for the period of 1/1/22 through 3/2/23 will be \$213,781. They would like to give \$137,189 to the Vigo County Parks Department so they can complete their trails project. Expenditures of this type are approved under the guidelines of the Indiana State Board of Health, State Board of Accounts and Department of Local Government Finance. Adam Grossman, Parks Superintendent, gave a brief presentation of how the money would be used to complete the recreational trail program and the additional improvements that would be made.

ii. Additional Appropriation Ordinance 2023-16B: Commissioners – Office Furniture

Commissioner Mike Morris said they had an appropriation in their 2022 budget that was going to be used to replace the chairs in the Council chambers. Unfortunately, the money did not get encumbered and went back into the general fund. They are asking for an appropriation to pay for the new chairs.

iii. Additional Appropriation Ordinance 2023-17B: Building Maintenance

Commissioner Mark Clinkenbeard spoke on behalf of the Commissioners and expressed their support of this request. Ricky Hammond, Maintenance Supervisor, explained that these appropriation requests were needed to cover expenses in order to maintain the new Vigo County Jail. The preventive maintenance that will be supplied under the contracts that these appropriations will pay for will help cut the costs of replacing large ticket items that are needed to run the facility. His budget sustained large cuts for this year and he was given the task of maintaining this large new facility. He may have to come back again this year for additional money to be able to maintain the new facility along with all the other county buildings. He explained the need and reasoning behind the four items he wanted to contract out. He was also asking for some additional money in his payroll budget to pay for the overtime accumulated by his department due largely in maintenance

for the new Jail. It is hard for them to be able to use the comp time that is currently being accumulated and still keep the department running smoothly. Chief Deputy Auditor Cheryl Loudermilk explained that the contract expenses on this request were also advertised under LIT/Correctional Rehab since those expenses were solely for maintenance of the Jail and would allow the Council the option to have those items paid from either budget. There was a short discussion.

- iv. Additional Appropriation 2023-18B: LIT/Correctional Rehab See narrative on Item iii explaining this appropriation.
- v. Salary Ordinance 2023-18A: Veterans Assistance This item was withdrawn.

Public Comments

Marie Theisz expressed appreciation to the Commissioners for all their efforts and assistance that had been provided to Sullivan County in the aftermath of the tornado that had occurred over the weekend. Mark Clinkenbeard gave a brief update on further cleanup efforts that were planned.

Vicki Weger made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved and the meeting adjourned at 5:48 p.m.

March 7, 2023 Sunshine Meeting March 14, 2023 Meeting

There were no corrections to the minutes of the March 7, 2023 Sunshine meeting. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 7, 2023 Sunshine meeting. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the March 14, 2023 meeting. Marie Theisz made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 14, 2023 meeting. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Communications from elected officials, other officials or agencies of the County

Auditor James Bramble submitted the TIF Management Report prepared by the Department of Redevelopment. These are submitted each year and require no action by the Council other than acknowledgement of receipt. Receipt is hereby acknowledged.

Reports from committee(s)

President Thacker said the Baker Tilly salary study is ongoing. Meetings took place last week between Jada Kent of Baker Tilly and any department heads who desired to meet and discuss the data. Ms. Kent will put together a report and forward it to the Council with possible recommendations and the Council will then take action and he hoped to be able to get something to the Budget Committee. There was a short discussion about how things might specifically be handled. Joni Wise, Vigo County Health Department, asked for clarification if there will be no action taken on the Baker Tilly study until the 2024 budget. President Thacker said that there were several possibilities going forward but no definite way to proceed has yet been established.

Ordinances relating to appropriations.

i. Additional Appropriation 2023-03B: Clerk – delete part time positions and add full time positions

This is the appropriation to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-03 which was approved at the March meeting for the Clerk's Office where 4 part time positions were deleted and 2 full time positions were added. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-03B. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

ii. Additional Appropriation 2023-05B: Juvenile Justice Center – Salary Increases, Stipends & Retention Bonuses

This is the appropriation to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-05 which was approved at the March meeting for the correctional officers at the Juvenile Justice Center to be paid the same pay rate as the correctional officers at the Jail. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-05B. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

iii. Additional Appropriation 2023-07B: Coroner Add Chief Deputy Coroner position

This is the appropriation to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-07 which was approved at the March meeting re-establishing a Chief Deputy Coroner position. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-07B. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

iv. Additional Appropriation 2023-10B: Sheriff – add secretary position

This is the appropriation to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-10 which was approved at the March meeting. This is a position that had been being paid from the Jail budget but should be paid out of the Sheriff's budget. Marie Theisz made a few brief comments and then made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-10B. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

v. Salary Ordinance 2023-20A: Sheriff - Add Corporal Stipend

This was originally submitted in February and was discussed at the Sunshine meeting. However, the salary ordinance was inadvertently omitted from both the February regular meeting and the March meetings. This will not require an additional appropriation since there is enough money currently appropriated to pay the stipend. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Salary Ordinance 2023-20A. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

vi. Additional Appropriation 2023-14B: Prosecutor – Add 1 Legal Secretary Position

This is the appropriation to fund Salary Ordinance 2023-14, as amended, which was approved at the March meeting. This is for an additional secretary to keep track of Community Service hours and other duties. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-14B. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

vii. Additional Appropriation 2023-15B: Vigo County Health Department – Reimburse Recreational Trails

This was discussed at the Sunshine meeting. Council had no additional questions. Marie Theisz made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-15B. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Before a vote was taken, Vicki Weger expressed her appreciation to the Health Department for all the contributions made with the funds they are receiving from the COVID vaccines reimbursements. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

viii. Additional Appropriation 2023-16B: Commissioners – Office Furniture

As explained at the Sunshine Meeting, this request is to pay for the chairs in the Council Chambers. The money had been in last year's budget but was inadvertently overlooked and did not get encumbered. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-16B. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

ix. Additional Appropriation 2023-17B: Building Maintenance

It was noted that this request had been advertised in two different funds because the contractual portions of the request, totaling \$143,490, were solely for the new Jail and could be paid from either General Fund/Building Maintenance or from LIT/Correctional Rehab which was to be used to solely pay for expenses for the Jail. The salary portion of the request, in the amount of \$12,185, would need to come from General Fund/Building Maintenance. There was a short discussion. Vicki Weger made a motion to amend Additional Appropriation 2023-17B to eliminate Contractual Services \$106,600, Bird & Pest Control \$1,800, Lawn Care \$19,200, and Simplex Fire Alarm \$15,890. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed. Vicki Weger moved to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-17B, as amended, in the amount of \$12,185. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

x. Additional Appropriation 2023-18B: LIT/Correction Rehab Facilities

This was discussed in conjunction with the prior requested Additional Appropriation. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2023-18B. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.
