## Pledge of Allegiance.

**Review of Minutes/Claims.** Chief Deputy Auditor Cheryl Loudermilk presented the Board with meeting minutes for October 3, 2023 for approval. Chris Switzer made a motion to approve the minutes for October 3, 2023. Mark Clinkenbeard seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 3-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Ms. Loudermilk then presented the Board with expenditures for the period of September 30, 2023 through October 6, 2023 in the amount of \$1,172,715.92. Mark Clinkenbeard made a motion to approve the September 30, 2023 through October 6, 2023 claims in the amount of \$1,172,715.92. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 3-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Micro Air Demolition Asbestos Inspection/Final Visual Inspection/Clearance Asbestos Air Monitoring, Old Jail - Commissioners. Chris Switzer said he had been working with Tyler Claypool of Garmong Construction. No matter what is decided regarding the old jail facility at 201 Cherry Street, we have to have a final inspection for air, asbestos and lead. Garmong has provided bids for each inspection. License Agreement for Use of Existing Handhole – Commissioners.
