Mike Morris called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Review of Minutes/Claims. Auditor James Bramble presented the Board with meeting minutes for October 10, 2023 for approval. Mark Clinkenbeard made a motion to approve the minutes for October 10, 2023. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 3-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Mr. Bramble then presented the Board with payroll for October 13, 2023 in the amount of \$1,428,426.14 for approval. Chris Switzer made a motion to approve the October 13, 2023 payroll. Mark Clinkenbeard seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 3-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Mr. Bramble then presented the Board with expenditures for the period of October 7, 2023 through October 13, 2023 in the amount of \$3,442,562.67. Mark Clinkenbeard made a motion to approve the October 7, 2023 through October 13, 2023 claims in the amount of \$3,442,562.67. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 3-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Public Comments. There were none.

Comments or other business from Commissioners or other Elected Officials. Larry Robbins, County Engineer, said they were winding up the paving and roadwork for the year and are working on the second Community Crossings award for this year. Robertson and New Goshen have already been paved, they working on Houseman now and will pick up Davis while they are down there. Miami Gardens is scheduled for the end of next week. They are starting the structures on Trueblood so that will probably be finished the middle of next month. The first Community Crossings project on Greencastle is being worked on now and should be finished by the end of the week so it should be on schedule to be finished in November. Mark Clinkenbeard said 911 should be operational by the middle of December. Councilman Todd Thacker said the final budget would be adopted tonight at the County Council meeting and there are some ARPA requests scheduled for voting. The meeting will be held at the City Court room in City Hall.

The meeting recessed at 9:07 a.m.




