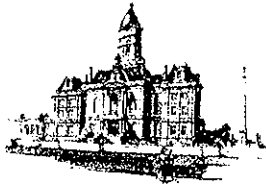

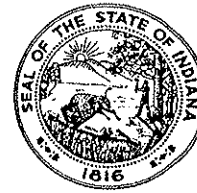

It is respectfully requested that the following issues be discussed at the Council Meeting:

We are requesting the council approve an appropriation on the Law Enforcement Grants line item in the Infraction Deferral budget for the following:

\$10,379.99 to be used for one time equipment purchases as follows:

\$2,295.00 for the purchase of a In-Car Dell Laptop Computer (\$700.00) and Police Radar Unit (\$1,595.00) for the Seelyville Town Marshall to outfit a new patrol vehicle. This will assist in keeping the Marshall safe and in making our community safer through patrol and traffic enforcement efforts.

\$8,084.99 (see quote) to purchase One CelleBrite Universal Forensic Extraction Device (UFED) System. This system allows law enforcement to retrieve data from digital devices for analysis and preservation of forensic evidence. The device also allows for the recovery of deleted, protected or hidden data and will make the recovery of such information/evidence more efficient, less time consuming. The Terre Haute Police Department recently had an evidence technician become certified in Cell Phone Technology and Forensic Data Recovery. This device will allow him to further utilize the training and certification he has received.

The additional appropriation in this line item will not result in any additional expenditure of county general funds, as the request would be funded from user funds generated through the infraction deferral program.

This is a proposal for the purchase of two pieces of equipment for the Seelyville Town Marshal's Office from the Vigo County Prosecutors office. As a small police department we only operate two police vehicles. We recently purchased a new fully marked patrol vehicle and placed in most of the essential needs for daily patrol operations.

Our newest vehicle does not have a Mobile Data Terminal (MDT). This presents several obstacles for our officer who operates this vehicle. This officer must return to the town hall to access report writing/arrest software, accident software, e-ticket software, and general police information essential to the officer during his tour of duty. This software, although being password protected access, is located on a computer that is shared with another town employee. This computer is only available if the other town employee is out of the office or not using the computer.

As a town which has the privilege of being located on U.S. Highway 40 we see an overwhelming amount of vehicular traffic. As with any four lane highway we receive many complains from the public of unsafe and aggressive driving along this highway and the adjoining side streets. Most of these complaints come in the form of speeding vehicles. Also most of our contacts with the public driving community occur on US 40 and are from traffic stops that we initiate. A new up to date police mobile radar unit will allow our officer to not only use visual means to monitor but also electric means to monitor the speed of vehicles.

This proposal is for the purchase of these two pieces of police equipment.
