Pledge of Allegiance. Mark Clinkenbeard called the meeting to order at 9:00a.m.

Review of minutes/claims. Auditor Larry Hutchings presented the Board with the minutes from the June 17, 2025 Meeting for approval. Mike Morris made a motion to approve the June 17, 2025 Meeting minutes as presented. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. With a voice vote of 3-0 the motion was passed.

Larry presented the payroll docket dated June 13, 2025 through June 20, 2025 in the amount of \$1,139,279.38 was presented to the Board. Mike Morris made a motion to approve the claims docket dated June 13, 2025 through June 20, 2025 in the amount of \$1,139,279.38. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. The motion passed upon a 3-0 vocal vote.

Larry then presented the claims docket dated June 13, 2025 through June 20, 2025 in the amount of \$80,439,337.09. Chris Switzer noted the city of Terre Haute was getting approximately \$16.3 million, Vigo County School Corporation was getting approximately \$23.4 Million, Vigo County Government was getting approximately \$21.4 Million, and the rest of the amount was for fire districts, townships, and towns. Chris Switzer made a motion to approve the claims docket dated June 13, 2025 through June 20, 2025 in the amount of \$80,439,337.09. Mike Morris seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 3-0 vote.
