

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF UPDATED ADA SELF-EVALUATION AND TRANSITION PLAN

Notice is hereby given that Vigo County is updating its self-evaluation of all County-owned facilities and programs for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Title II of the ADA requires that each of the County's services, programs, and activities be readily accessible and usable by individuals with disabilities.
