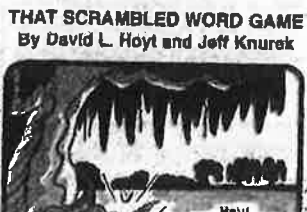

Letter to the County Council: For Sunshine meeting September 19, 2022

From: Vigo County Clerk's Office

I'm coming to you with a situation that has continued to escalate. As you know from other meetings, the Clerk's office is always fighting to keep employees. This month alone, we have/are losing 3 full time seasoned workers. Since April of this year, we have lost a total of 7. They are taking other positions within the County that pay more on the hour. This month, we have lost 2 full time staff members to the Prosecutors office and 1 to the Public Defender's office. Previously this year, we lost 2 staff members to the Harrison Township Assessor's office and 1 to the Juvenile Court.

Since the beginning of 2022, we have lost 12 people to other positions, retirement etc. At this pace, we are replacing a third of our staff and still have 4 months left of the year. We need to have people who will stay, and the way to do that is to increase their pay to be more competitive with the other department's salaries. With the election coming up, we are going to need our seasoned workers to pick up the slack for the new one's that haven't had time to be trained.

I am asking to increase all full time Clerks to \$20.00 an hour. They make \$18.09 now. That is an increase of \$1.91 an hour. The Prosecutors office starts at \$21.48, Public Defenders office starts at \$21.48 and even the Harrison Township Assessors office starts at \$19.48. Court staff make somewhere between \$21.00 and \$22.00.

In addition, I am asking to increase our supervisors from \$21.48 hr. to \$24.87 hr. and our assistant supervisors from \$19.48 hr. to \$21.48 hr.

Breakdown:

Deputy Clerks increase \$1.91 hr. each x 23 clerks = \$43.93 x 70 hrs. = \$3,075.10 x 26 pays per yr. = \$79,952.60 x 7.65% fica = \$6,116.37. Perf at 14.2% = \$11,353.27. Total increase for Deputy Clerks would be **\$97,422.24.**

Asst. Supervisors increase \$2.00 hr. x 2 asst. supervisors = \$4.00 x 70 hrs. = \$280.00 x 26 pays per yr. = \$7,280.00 x 7.65% fica = \$556.92. Perf at 14.2% = \$1,033.76. Total increase for Asst. Supervisors would be **\$8,870.68.**

Supervisors increase \$3.39 hr. x 5 supervisors = \$16.95 x 70 hrs. = \$1,186.50 x 26 pays per year = \$30,849.00 x 7.65 fica = \$2,359.95. Perf at \$14.2% = \$4,380.56. Total increase for Supervisors would be **\$37,589.51.**

Total increase in payroll for the Clerk's office would be \$143,882.43 yr.
