less than full time employees. They are assigned and perform the same job. The only difference should be benefits such as insurance, We are requesting they are paid on the same pay scale as correctional staff (jail section). This request includes line-level personnel as required training and level of risk they face on a daily basis. We also believe there is no valid reason why part time (\$14.77) is paid We are submitting a request for an increase in hourly wage for our building security division to be implemented as soon as possible. well as supervisory positions, such as Corporal and Sergeant. We believe these personnel are deserving of this increase due to their retirement, etc. It is extremely difficult to find part time help at such a low rate.
