Program Activities – 2009

Activities and Accomplishments:

Major changes in our program during 2009 include one counselor leaving our employ and another being hired, same as last year. Sherri Andrews left employment and Sally Burnham was hired.. Sally will begin attending training sessions to pursue her CSAMS. Crystal Brooks completed additional training in pursuit of her CSAMS certification, and Kari Davis was awarded her CSAMS certificate.

We continued the use of our in-house lab arrangement and processed nearly 7,000 specimens for the Courts, the A&D Program, Drug Court and Adult Probation. We provided additional instant test cups to our local jail. We collected fewer samples than last year, in large part due to clients being tested at other facilities through ATR funding.

We continued to offer an 8-hour Level I Basic Substance Abuse Education program and a Level II 16-hour Substance Abuse Education program as well as coordinating an in-house jail treatment linkage program with a variety of treatment providers, offered several education courses for prosecutorial diversion programs, worked extensively with the LCC and the local chapter of MADD.

Income and Expenditures:

Our Program had expenditures of \$427,728.25 in 2009 while garnering income of \$419,732.35. We ended the year with \$84,012.24 cash on hand and \$112,850.11 in investments. We continued to support Drug Court in a variety of ways. For the 2010 budget, we have reduced spending by 7.5% and have taken strides to increase revenue while cutting costs.
