There were no corrections to the minutes of the November 8, 2023 Sunshine Meeting. Travis Norris made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 8, 2023 Sunshine Meeting. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the November 14, 2023 Meeting. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 14, 2023 Meeting. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the January 9, 2024 reorganizational meeting. Nancy Allsup made a motion to approve the minutes of the reorganizational meeting. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

<u>Communications from elected officials, other officials or agencies of the County</u> Commissioner Mark Clinkenbeard announced that Amazon will be building a hub in the Industrial Park that is called the Last Mile delivery hub. They will have 80-100 part time and full time jobs with another possible 80-100 private contractor jobs. They are asking for no tax abatements.

Resolutions and Ordinances other than appropriations.

i. Resolution 2024-05: Council – Authorizing Advance Payments for Goods and Services

Council Attorney Michael Wright summarized the purpose of this Resolution. County Auditor Jim Bramble added that the newly passed law codifies the way things really

work. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve this request. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

ii. Resolution of Reallocation 2024-01: Vigo County Juvenile Court – Out-of-Series Transfer

This had been presented at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Aaron Loudermilk made a motion to approve this request. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

iii. Resolution of Reallocation 2024-02: Area Planning – Out-of-Series Transfer

This had been presented at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Marie Theisz made a motion to approve this request. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

iv. Resolution of Reallocation 2024-03: EDIT – Parks – Land Acquisition – Out-of-Series Transfer

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger commented that this request shows the ingenuity of our Parks Superintendent, Adam Grossman. Ms. Weger then made a motion to approve this request. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a roll call vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

v. Resolution of Reallocation 2024-04: EDIT – Parks – Improvements – Out-of-Series Transfer

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Marie Theisz made a motion to approve this request. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a roll call vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

Ordinances relating to appropriations.

i. Additional Appropriation 2024-01: Local Public Health Services – Contractual Services

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-01. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

ii. Additional Appropriation 2024-02: LHD Trust – Contractual Services

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-02. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

iii. Additional Appropriation 2024-03: Health Maintenance – Contractual Services

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-03. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

iv. Additional Appropriation 2024-05: Alternative Dispute Resolution – Legal Services

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Travis Norris made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-05. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

v. Additional Appropriation 2024-04: EDIT – Community Crossing Grant Match

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-04. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

vi. Additional Appropriation 2024-06: ARPA Grant Fund – Recreational Trails Project

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. This money had been appropriated last year but because there was no contract in place at the end of 2023, it will need to be reappropriated this year. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-06. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

vii. Additional Appropriation 2024-07: ARPA Grant Fund – Culvert & Drainage Projects

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. This also had been appropriated last year but was not under contract at the end of 2023 and needs to be reappropriated. Council had no further questions. Nancy Allsup made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-07. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

viii. Additional Appropriation 2024-08: ARPA Grant Fund – Hasselburger Bridge Improvement

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Marie Theisz made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-08. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

ix. Additional Appropriation 2024-09: ARPA Grant Fund – Courthouse Dome Cleaning & Painting

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-09. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

x. Additional Appropriation 2024-10: ARPA Grant Fund – Courthouse Roof Repair

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-10. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xi. Additional Appropriation 2024-11: ARPA Grant Fund – County Annex Parking Lot Seal & Stripe

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Marie Theisz asked if the striping would remain the same or if any new configuration was planned. No changes were planned. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-11. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xii. Additional Appropriation 2024-12: ARPA Grant Fund – Community Corrections

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Marie Theisz briefly reviewed the purpose of this request. Council had no further questions. Marie Theisz then made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-12. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xiii. Additional Appropriation 2024-13: ARPA Grant Fund - Sheriff

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Travis Norris said that he had reached out to the Sheriff's Department about their current inventory and had gathered the following information. Since January of 2023 through today, there were 658 transports done, 2 trips to Arkansas, 20 to Illinois, and 2 to Kentucky. Non-scheduled hospital details through the same dates are 249 inmates sent out urgently with a total time spent on these being 165 days, 20 hours, 8 minutes. One of the hospital details lasted 43 days and was in Indianapolis. That particular detail placed 20,665.8 miles on the fleet driving back and forth. Court transfers average 28 trips per week to the Court House. In conjunction with the Courts, they are working on using the court space in the current jail to cut down on some of these trips which will help with reduction of time and mileage. All vehicles have 150,000 plus miles with the exception of two. It is hoped to see some reductions with the use of the court space located in the new jail. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-13. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xiv. Additional Appropriation 2024-14: ARPA Grant Fund - Veterans Point Tiny Homes for Vets

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Nancy Allsup made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-14. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xv. Additional Appropriation 2024-15: ARPA Grant Fund – Vigo County Historical Society

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Marie Theisz made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-15. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xvi. Additional Appropriation 2024-16: ARPA Grant Fund – Vigo Rural Water Study

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. President Thacker summarized this request. Council had no further questions. Nancy Allsup made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-16. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xvii. Additional Appropriation 2024-17: ARPA Grant Fund – VCSC Mental Health Program

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-17. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xviii. Additional Appropriation 2024-18: E-Share Asset Forfeiture – New Equipment

This was explained at the Sunshine Meeting. This request was for red dot sights for guns. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-18. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

xix. Additional Appropriation 2024-19: E-Share Asset Forfeiture - Vehicle

This was explained at the Sunshine Meeting. Aaron Loudermilk had to leave the Sunshine meeting when this was presented and asked if this was a reimbursement. He also asked if the Department already had the vehicle in its possession. Officer Derek Fell said they did have the vehicle but no payments had been made. Councilman Loudermilk asked if this request was not approved if there was backup plan on how to pay for it. Officer Fell said it would have to be paid out of Commissary. Officer Fell did not know how long they had the vehicle but said it was not very long. This vehicle would go to one of the two officers who had been added at the beginning of this year. One of those

officers would be going back to Investigations and would need an unmarked vehicle to drive. Council had no further questions. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Additional Appropriation 2024-19. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 5-1 with Aaron Loudermilk voting nay, the motion carried.

xx. Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-20A: Sheriff – Captain Position

This had been explained at the Sunshine Meeting. President Thacker gave a brief review of what it entailed. Chief Deputy Auditor Cheryl Loudermilk said the stipend for the captain was inadvertently omitted during the budget process for 2024 and this will address that issue. There was a brief discussion. Councilman Loudermilk asked if Captain was a merit position. Officer Derek Fell said captains are appointed positions through state statute. It is a merited full time deputy. This is not an added position, it is a change in title. Councilman Loudermilk asked if the appointment had already been made. Officer Fell replied that there is someone filling that role (the job description and duties) but the position cannot be funded without Council approval. They have been doing this job for 2-3 weeks. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-20A. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

xxi. Salary Ordinance 2024-21A: Courts - Budget Adjustment

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. President Thacker noted that the Courts were asking that the System Administrator be added back to the Courts budget and removed from the IT budget. This change had taken place during budget meetings for 2024. Aaron Loudermilk made a motion to approve Salary Ordinance 2024-21A. Councilwoman Vicki Weger said she would like to have this referred to the Budget Committee for next month. President Thacker said there was a motion to approve on the floor and would need to be dealt with first. There was no second for the motion and the motion died for lack of a second. Ms. Weger then made a motion to refer this to the Budget Committee for further information. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. A short discussion took place about how this came about during budget discussions for 2024. Chief Judge Sarah Mullican stated that the position had been created for the Courts because of confidentiality of employees. Chief Deputy Prosecutor Rob Roberts also spoke in favor of the separation of the position back to the Courts budget. Councilwoman Theisz asked for clarification that Mr. Roberts was supporting the separation of the position back to the Courts budget. Mr. Roberts replied affirmatively. Councilwoman Theisz asked for clarification one last time before a vote was taken. President Thacker then called for a voice vote to send this back to the Budget Committee, which resulted in more than one nay vote. A roll call vote was then taken with voting as follows: Aaron Loudermilk - nay; Nancy Allsup - aye; Vicki Weger - aye; Todd Thacker - aye; Marie Theisz - aye; Travis Norris - nay. With a vote of 4-2, the motion carried.

xxii. Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-22A: Local Public Health Services - Stipends

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Todd Thacker gave a brief review of the reason for this request. Chief Deputy Auditor Cheryl Loudermilk said the amounts for the stipends had been taken back to January 1 to clear this up. This is being amended to take them to the mid-point based on the Baker Tilly study. Nancy Allsup made a motion to approve Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-22A. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

xxiii. Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-23A: Prosecutor – Amend Legal Secretary Position

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Todd Thacker gave a brief review of the reason for this request. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-23A. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

xxiv. Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-24A: Courts – Salary Adjustment for Case Managers

This matter had been discussed at the Sunshine Meeting. Chief Deputy Auditor Cheryl Loudermilk briefly reviewed this request. There are 2 screening analyst/case managers who are paid by the County and two who are paid from a grant. These positions were not part of the Baker Tilly study. When raises were discussed, these positions were not included because it was not certain that the same raise could be given to the 2 grant funded positions and it was intended that all 4 positions be paid the same. It was determined by the State at a later date after raises were given at budget time for County employees that the grant funded positions could receive the 3% raise. Now, it is being requested that the two County positions receive a 3% increase. It was also pointed out that the grant funded positions had not received the 3% increase, and would not, unless the County increased the other two positions by 3%. This was presented as retroactive to January 1 but if Council chooses a different effective date, that part of the appropriation will need to be amended. Ms. Loudermilk did note that the total cost to the County would be \$2,603. Vicki Weger made a motion to approve Amended Salary Ordinance 2024-24A and for it to be effective as of January 1, 2024. Nancy Allsup seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 6-0, the motion unanimously passed.

RESOLUTION 2024-05

AUTHORIZATION OF ADVANCE PAYMENTS FOR GOODS AND SERVICES

The Vigo County Council (the "Council") met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council held on the date set forth below, such meeting being called pursuant to a notice stating the time, place, and purpose of the meeting received by all Council members and published in the Tribune-Star newspaper, and posted for the public. The following resolution was made, seconded and adopted by a majority of those present at the meeting, which constituted a legal quorum of the Council.

WHEREAS, the Council is a political subdivision as defined in Indiana Code Section 36-1-2-13; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has enacted Public Law 181-2023 (the "Act"), which allows political subdivisions to make advance payments for goods or services before the goods are delivered or services are completed if the fiscal body of the political subdivision authorized making such advance payments; and

WHEREAS, the Council is the fiscal body of Vigo County and the Council desires to allow advance payments for goods and services purchased by the Council in certain circumstances in accordance with the Act to provide for better operating efficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated hereby by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Council is hereby authorized to make advance payments for goods or services before the goods are delivered or services are completed in compliance with the Act and this Resolution.

Section 3. Advance payments for goods and services may not exceed the lesser of the following:

- (a) Fifty percent (50% of the entire cost of the contract);
- (b) Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00); or
- (c) Such lesser amount established by the Council on a case by case basis.

Section 4. In the event advance payments are made, the Auditor, as the fiscal officer of the Council, shall do the following as required by the Act:

- (a) Track any prepayments by defining the prepayment on a purchase order;
- (b) Create a prepayment invoice that is associated with the purchase order; and

(c) Require insurance or a surety bond in the amount of the prepayment if the amount of the prepayment is more than One Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$150,000.00).

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
