Communications from elected officials, other officials or agencies of the County

a. Additional Appropriation relating to the Vigo County General Revenue Bonds, series 2019 by the Vigo County Capital Improvement Board of Managers for the purpose of funding the construction of the Terre Haute Convention Center. Brian Bosma, an attorney with Kroger, Gardis & Regas representing the CIB, is working with county commissioners on the bond appropriation for the convention center. He stated the general revenue bonds will be no greater than \$22 million. The interest cost for the bond would decrease if it were a one bond issue for the convention center in lieu of each party involved issuing bonds individually. The commissioners are also requesting the county to appropriate five million dollars in the EDIT fund for the project. The total project cost of \$27 million includes the \$5 million from the EDIT fund.

- a. Annual Budget
 - i. Resolution 2019-07 a Resolution of the County Council of Vigo County, Indiana Approving Inter-local Cooperation Agreement for Joint Financing of Convention Center. Brian Bosma and other representatives of the Capital Improvement Board discussed the Multi-Party Agreement regarding joint financing of the Terre Haute Convention Center. This resolution is approving an Inter-local Agreement for Joint Financing of Convention Center by the County, the City and its Mayor and the Terre Haute Convention and Visitors Bureau. Amendments to the Inter-local Agreement were proposed (amended agreement attached). Motion: to amend Resolution 2019-07 to include on page 9 the County Council, 127 Oak Street, Terre Haute, Indiana 47807 and the Effner Law Firm, 19 South 6th Street Suite 1200, Terre Haute, IN 47807 to the document that was received and also on Exhibit B on page 3 part 3 to include the purpose of the general revenue bonds is to provide funds for the design and construction of the Convention Center and incidental expenses related thereto and cost of issuance of the bonds. It is the intent of the parties that the bond payments are to be paid from annual contributions to the CIB according to the schedule from Vigo County, City of Terre Haute, and the Terre Haute Convention and Visitors Bureau pursuant to this agreement along with tax revenues from the Vigo County Food & Beverage tax, Action: Approved, Moved by: Jim Mann, Seconded by: Vicki Weger. Motion passed unanimously.

ii. Ordinance 2019-01 Ordinance of the Vigo County Council Authorizing the Issuance of County General Revenue Bonds for the Purpose of Providing Funds to be

Applied to the Costs Incurred by the Vigo County Capital Improvement Board of Managers for the Terre Haute Convention Center and Incidental Expenses in Connection Therewith and Costs of the Issuance of the Bonds and Appropriating the Proceeds Thereof and Additional Funds. Brian Bosma discussed the issuance of bonds to pay all or a portion of the costs of the project, capitalized interest, debt service reserve, and any expenses that may occur with the bonds. He also discussed the amendments that were made to Ordinance 2019-01. i. Additional Appropriation 2019-13. County General /Sheriff -Vehicles. Derek Fell, a representative spoke on the Sheriff's request. The Sheriff is requesting \$12,304.80 to be appropriated to account 1000.44460.000.0005 Vehicles to be used to purchase a replacement vehicle. A 2014 Ford Explorer was totaled in an accident and the insurance settlement was for the same amount. There will be 6 traveling. He is also asking for an additional appropriation in the amount of \$5,000.00 to Contractual Services in Seized Assets/ Drug task Force for cell phone stipends for

He is proposing to eliminate the Bailiff position and create a Court Reporter/Bailiff position to perform the duties of both positons. - ii. Additional Appropriation Ordinance 2019-12 County General/Courts. An additional appropriation to fund the increase for the Court Reporter/Bailiff position. Motion: to approve Additional Appropriation 2019-12, Action: Approved, Moved by: Jim Mann, Seconded by: David Thompson.

- d. Public Safety LIT Distribution to Township Units. When the LIT Public Safety Tax was passed in 2018, it was with the expectation the township units were going to receive the distributions directly but there was a problem with the language in the ordinance and distribution to the township units was not certified by the Department of Local Government. In order for the township units to receive the distributions directly from the county, they would need to make a request and that request would need to meet a core county function, such as economic development. Another option is to adopt a resolution for next year. It would require the units to file a request by July 1, 2019 for distribution in 2020. The typical distributions would be based on the percentage of levy of each fire district or fire department. A handout has been provided to the council with the total distribution. The amount to be distributed would be \$235,796.45. Council President Loudermilk is proposing the run counts for each unit to be considered since he feels it is a more accurate reflection of the operational costs of each unit. The handout includes options of using a combination of runs and levy to determine the allocation amounts. e. Commissioners: approval of Acquisition of Real; Estate for the proposed Vigo County Security Annex per Resolution 2019-03. County Attorney Mike Wright discussed the document that was prepared with the appraisals which were authorized by the Resolution that the council approved and was received. These appraisals formed the basis of which the County can acquire property. They are choosing to move forward with 22.2 acres formerly known as Stu's Golf Course for the site of the new jail.
