
ORDER

Plaintiffs, having filed their Response to Defendants' Monthly Status Report and Motion for Parties to Appear to Discuss Status, and the Court having reviewed the matter and being duly advised, finds that consistent with its Order of October 10, 2018 (Dkt. 146 at 18, ¶1), the defendants should be ordered to appear before the Court to discuss the status of the matter, and particularly all efforts made to address the population and population pressures on the Vigo County Jail.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that on November 6, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. in Room 131 of the United States Courthouse located at 921 Ohio Street, Terre Haute, Indiana, the Vigo County Sheriff, President of the Vigo County Council, President of the Vigo County Commissioners, any other individuals who possess information necessary to provide a complete report SHALL appear to discuss the status of this case and particularly if all entities associated

with the criminal justice system in Vigo County, including the state-court judges, prosecutor, public defenders, probation department, and community corrections, have been consulted about additional measures that can be taken to respond to the population issue and the results of those consultations.
