**AMENDED STANDING ORDER
TO ATTEND TRANSPARENTING CLASS**


The Vigo Superior Courts find that it would be in the best interest of the minor child/children of the parties to encourage better communication and cooperation between divorcing parents prior to and after the dissolution of their marriage. The Court further finds that a Transparenting Class will:

1. Aid the parents in post-separation parenting;
2. Aid the Court in maximizing the use of the Court's time;
3. Encourage agreements between the parties concerning child-related matters.


Therefore, the Vigo Superior Court, Divisions 1, 2, 3, and 6 ORDER both parties in any cause of action for Dissolution of Marriage or Legal Separation, in which there are minor children, to attend the online parent workshop at www.uptoparents.org. The workshop is FREE and the attendance is MANDATORY for all parties in a Dissolution of Marriage or Legal Separation action that is filed on or after January 1, 2024, if there are un-emancipated children under 18 years of age. The course must be completed and written commitments must be completed and filed prior to the Final Hearing. Parties may participate in other similar type workshops, but ONLY with a specific Court Order authorizing the alternate workshop.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the parties in the cause of action for a divorce and/or legal separation with minor children are ordered to begin the FREE online workshop at: www.uptoparents.org within thirty (30) days of their notice of this Order and to submit a certificate of completion of the workshop prior to the Final Hearing. Failure to complete the workshop could result in a party having to show cause why he/she should not be held in contempt of Court.


The Court's Amended Standing Order dated June 4, 2019 is hereby rescinded and declared null and void.




