Vigo County Courthouse Security Camera Project

Vigo County Courthouse located at 33 S 3rd Street, Terre Haute, IN 47804, is accepting proposals for a new security camera system.

Project Requirements/Notes:

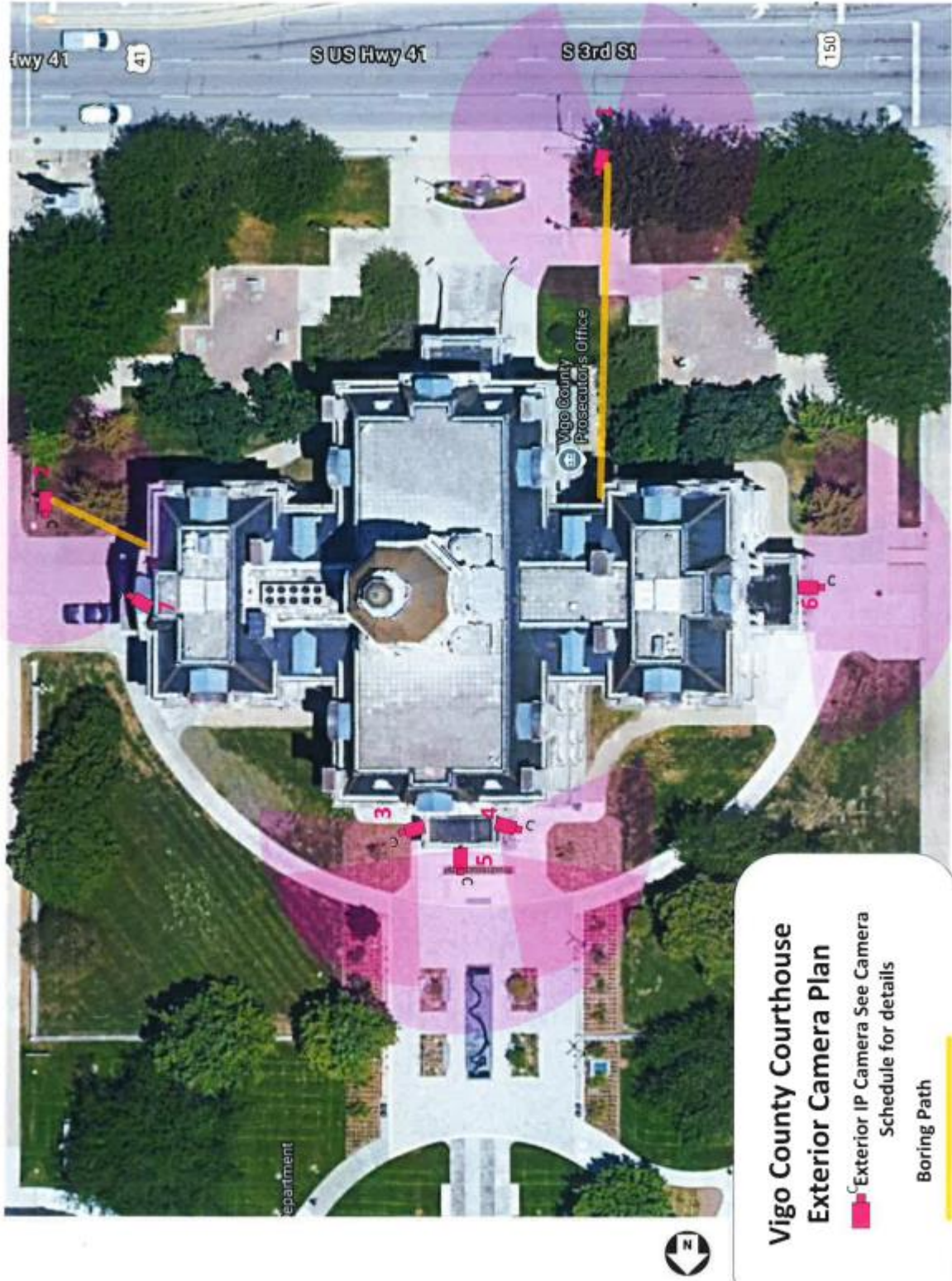
1. Failure to meet or exceed the following specifications may be sufficient reason to reject submitted proposal.
2. All equipment must be NDAA Compliant.
3. ExacqVision is the brand of Video Management Software that is currently in place and should be used for this project. Include one year of updates for the ExacqVision software. Your quote will not be accepted if ExacqVision is not used as the VMS.
4. Rack Mounted Server Specs – Minimum Xeon Silver 4310 12C/24T Processor, 64GB RAM, 480GB SSD for Server 2022 Standard OS, RAID 5 Configuration with a hot spare storage drive installed in server, redundant power supplies & include 5 year NBD hardware warranty.
5. A minimum of 30 Days of video retention, all cameras recording at their highest resolution at 25 frames per second, medium activity, 8 hours per day. Cameras can be set to record on motion but must be set at high sensitivity to ensure all motion is recorded.
6. Cameras 1 & 2 will require boring to the building. Contractor is to install 1" conduit from camera location to building. All outdoor cabling must be rated for outdoor use and should transition to plenum rated cable once it is inside the building.
7. The courthouse/county will be responsible for locating all private utilities.
8. Camera 1 will require contractor to provide and install a street light pole 13-16ft tall.
9. Camera 2 will be mounted to the existing light pole.
10. All network cabling that is exposed to outdoor elements should be outdoor rated and installed in conduit.
11. Surface mount raceway should be used for all cabling that is not in the ceiling/hidden (no cabling should be seen).
12. All exterior, first and second floor camera cabling will run to the MDF and should terminate onto a new patch panel provided by contractor.
13. Provide and install managed 48 port Gigabit PoE network switch in MDF along with all patch cables to connect server, cameras and 3rd floor IDF using existing 62.5 MM fiber.
14. All third and fourth floor camera cabling will run to the third floor IDF. Contractor will be required to install a 4RU, hinged wall bracket with 24 port Gigabit PoE Network switch, 24 port patch panel and all necessary patch cables to connect cameras and switch to MDF using the existing 62.5 MM fiber.
15. All network switches must be manageable and from a reputable manufacturer (HP, Cisco, Aruba, etc).
16. All network cabling is to be certified and labeled per national standards. All certification results will be provided to courthouse in digital pdf format.
17. Camera brand can be substituted in place of Axis but must meet all technical and warranty specs.
18. All cameras to include a 5 year manufacturers warranty.
19. Contractor will provide a 5 year labor warranty for all items included in the project except viewing monitors.
20. Existing IP Camera Cabling – Contractor can use the network cabling already in place for the existing IP cameras that will be replaced. Existing cabling should be certified, labeled and test results provided to the courthouse.
21. Security Viewing Station – Provide a Dell Precision or equivalent PC with 43" monitor for camera viewing at security desk.
22. Provide additional 43" Monitor for existing camera viewing station in security office.
23. Contractor to ensure all mounting hardware is included for proper camera installation.

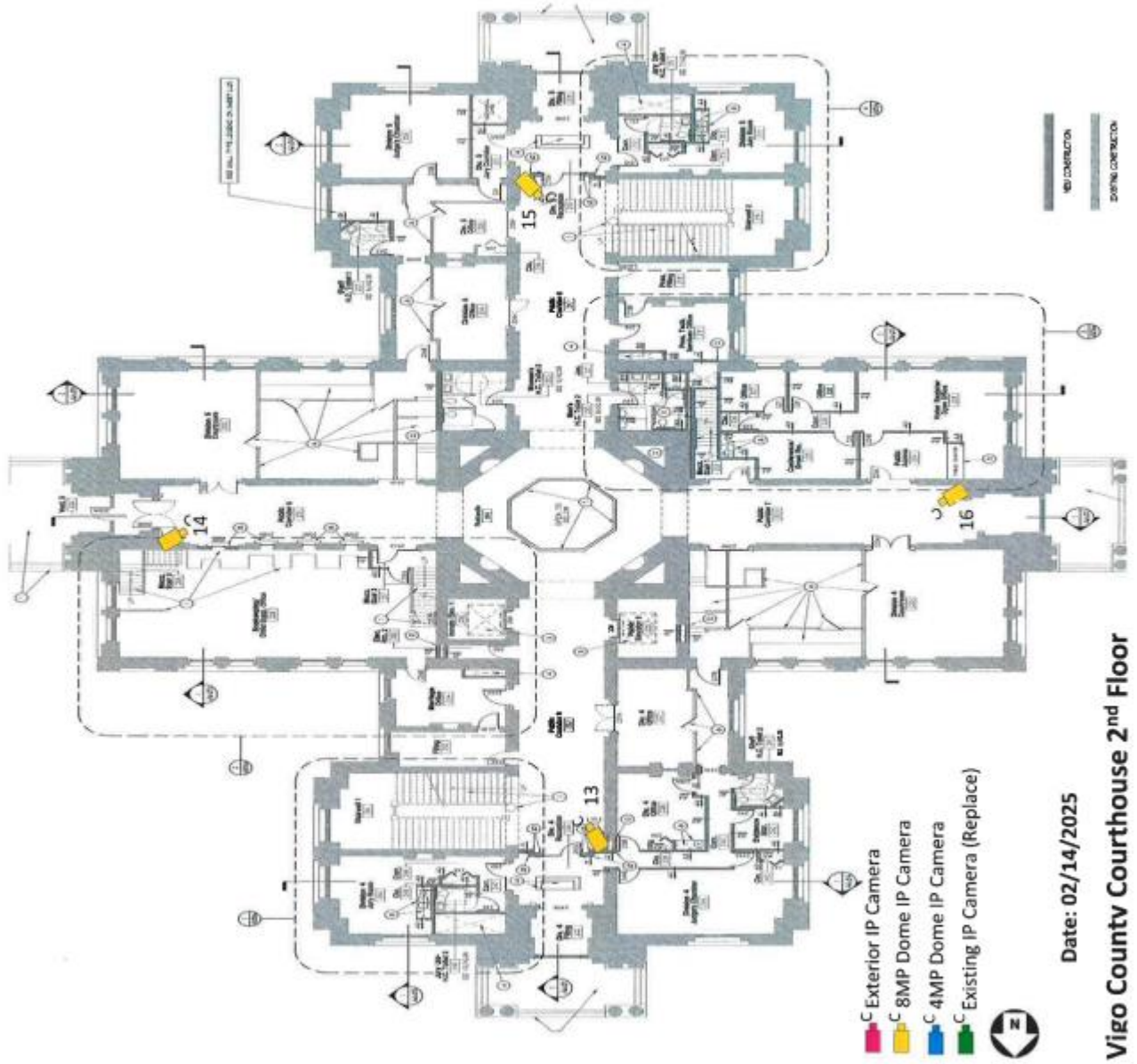

Re: Vigo Superior Court 2 Request for Fund Appropriation

Dear Council Members,

For several years, the Vigo County Clerk's Office has been collecting on behalf of the Vigo County Courts a \$20 fee in all divorce case filings, except when a waiver is filed and approved. These fees are maintained in the Alternative Dispute Resolution Fund #2200 and currently has a balance of sixty six thousand five hundred sixty-nine dollars and twelve cents. (\$66,569.12).

This Alternative Dispute Resolution Fund #2200 can be used in family court for domestic relations cases for the following kinds of limited purposes: mediation, facilitation, parent coordinators, co-parenting, conflict management, counseling/education, parenting classes, and those types of services as approved for use through the Indiana Office of Court Services.

It is impossible to predict in any given year, how much money will be expended from the Fund to ensure that families can obtain necessary services ordered by the Court. Accordingly, a request is being made to appropriate the entire Fund amount to ensure sufficient funds are available if and when necessary. The Alternative Dispute Resolution Fund #2200 belongs to the Court and cannot revert back to the general fund and each year a request will be made for the appropriation of the entire amount of the Fund for the benefit of families in need. Payments will be made to directly to vendors providing services to the families.

Dear Honorable County Council Members,

Please consider this letter as a formal request to be placed on the Council's Log for the meeting March 4, 2025, and to be voted on March 11, 2025. I am asking the Council to approve an appropriation from the Juvenile Justice Non-Reverting Fund #4959 in the amount of \$100,000.00 to various line items listed below that will be used to help re-establish the Vigo County Homes for Children.

I was recently appointed as the Director of the Vigo County Homes for Children and at that time asked the Commissioners to amend General Ordinance 2020-1, which established a Non-Reverting Fund for the Detention Center that used captured revenue for holding juveniles from counties other than Vigo County, to be used at the Group Homes. This money can be used for only specific purposes which are listed in the ordinance which I have attached for your review.

The current fund balance for the Juvenile Justice Non-Reverting Fund is \$432,014.87 as of the date of this letter. Even with the 2025 Adopted Budget already removed, there is still enough money available to help the Group Homes with a **one-time appropriation to assist with start up costs**.

Judge Mullican, Sheriff Fell, and The Commissioners have met several times to discuss the amount needed to get the group homes in a position to re-open and receive children. For this to happen we desperately need to repair and refurbish the Glen Home located at 1308 South 6th Street.

This money will be used as start-up costs such as clothing, bedding, hygiene supplies, beds, furniture and food. In addition, money will be used for kitchen appliances and repairs to the home. I would welcome you all to come to the group home to see for yourself the need for this appropriation.

Dear Honorable County Council Members,

Please consider this letter as a formal request to be placed on the Council's Log for the meeting March 4, 2025, and to be voted on March 11, 2025. I am asking the Council to approve an amendment to the 2025 Salary Ordinance for the re-structuring of positions within the Vigo County Home for Children Budget.

I was recently appointed as the Director of the Vigo County Homes for Children and at that time met with members of the Indiana Division of Child Services (DCS) and the Commissioners to see how to better manage the operations of the group homes in general. Below is a list of changes that I am requesting that the County Council grant. They are:

1. **Eliminate Office Manager position (\$41,332)**
2. **Eliminate Maintenance Supervisor Grade 8 (\$24.19/hour)**
3. **Change Position Title: Continued Care Worker to Family and Youth Services Coordinator From: Grade 12 (\$56,628) To: Grade 13 (\$60,308)**
4. **Change Position Title: Therapeutic Family Case Manger to Compliance/Financial Manager: Grade 10 (\$49,926) To: Grade 12 (\$56,628)**
5. **Change Position Title From: Program Director to Operations Director: Grade 14 (\$64,229) To: Grade 15 (\$68,403)**
6. **Change position of Treatment/Licensing Director from: Grade 15 (\$68,403) To: Grade 16 (\$72,850)**
7. **Add Maintenance Position in the Building Maintenance Department Grade 7 (\$22.71/ hour)**

The Vigo County Homes for Children are beginning anew, and with that thought process, needs to change their dynamics and operational models. These changes, if approved, will allow us to utilize staff in the most efficient way possible. Currently many of the duties and responsibilities are blurred and confusing to the administration and staff alike. This is the first step to moving this department forward.

To summarize my request, we will be eliminating the Office Manager position and combining the duties with the old Therapeutic Family Case Manager, renaming it the Compliance/Financial Manager. Next is changing the old Continued Care Worker and Therapeutic Family Case Manager to the new Youth Services Coordinator. This will combine many of those two positions into one.

We are also asking for the title and grade change from the old Program Manager to Operations Director. This new position will be used to help oversee and schedule the Directo Care Staff and coordinate all operational activity. Additionally, we are asking to change the grade and title for the Treatment Director to add Treatment/Licensing Director. The Indiana Department of Child Services requires a master's degree to hold an Administrator License for the Group Home. For the group Homes to stay in good standing with DCS, the licensee must hold an advanced degree. This position will require a master's degree in the human services field so that we will meet those requirements set forth by the State of Indiana.

Lastly, we would request that the Maintenance Supervisor position be removed from the Vigo County Homes for Children and move to the Building Maintenance Budget. It is an old position that was recently vacated and needs to be moved into the Maintenance Budget with the other maintenance positions. Also, the position in the Group Home budget was classified as a Grade 8 and needs to be reduced to a Grade 7 like the maintenance workers.

County savings for eliminating Office Manager and reclassifying Maintenance Specialist =

\$44,025.60 salary + \$22,779.32 benefits = \$66,804.92

Increase to the county for position reclassifications =

\$19,003 salary + \$4,152.16 benefits = \$23,155.16

For a total saving = \$43,649.76

Mr. Hutchings,

The Assessor's office respectfully requests to be placed on the agenda for the March 2025 Vigo County Council Sunshine and Regular Meetings to discuss a salary ordinance amendment.

To assess real and personal property in Indiana you must attain a Level II Assessor certification at a minimum. Although the State does account for a small stipend for having this level, it does not reflect the amount of work that goes into getting this certification, or the amount of continued education you are required to take to maintain it. During the Baker Tilly study, and during 2024 budget cycle, I strongly expressed how this should be taken into consideration during the grading process. Because of this I am requesting one of two options:

Option 1: All County and Township deputies have their grades increased from a Grade 7 to a Grade 8, the Harrison Township Chief Deputy be increased from a Grade 11 to a Grade 12, the County Chief Deputy be increased from a Grade 12 to a Grade 13, the Harrison Township Assessor grade to increase from Grade 515 to Grade 516, and the County Assessor grade increase from Grade 516 to Grade 517.

Option 2: All County and Township staff, including Township Assessor and County Assessor, be moved to the midpoint of their current grade.

To cover the additional expense of these changes, the Harrison Township Assessor has agreed to decrease their staff by 1 full time employee. Harrison Township and the County Assessor share 6,000 part time hours that can be used between the two offices which are budgeted for. We will agree to surrender 4,000 of those hours.

By making these concessions you can see, not only is it at a 0 cost to the County, it will be a savings to the County. Below is a chart showing the changes and the results.
